Help California Save Resources by Recycling When at School!

1. Designate a school "Recycling Coordinator" to oversee the program and motivate others.
2. Arrange for collection: Contact your local recycler or designate a student(s).
3. Get recycling bins by calling 1-800-RECYCLE or by logging on to bottlesandcans.com.
4. Place recycling bins in high traffic areas and inform students of their location.
6. Label the bins effectively to maximize ease of use.
5. Educate your students so they can identify CRV recyclable beverage containers. For a list of beverage containers included in the CRV program, visit bottlesandcans.com.
7. Introduce the program to your students with an email or posters to create awareness.
8. Generate enthusiasm by motivating your students with rewards paid for with the funds redeemed.
